

MISSIONS

I am Alicia Huerta, missionary of the *Fraternidad Misionera Verbum Dei*, of the Roman Catholic Church.

I think that the church must be missionary or isn't a Jesus's church, and as such I know I am sent by Him. I have been in so many countries of South America, mainly in Colombia (Bogotá, Medellín, Bucaramanga, Pereira) and Bolivia (Cochabamba).

The charisma that God has given to me through my community is to pray and preach the Gospel (Act. 6,4). With the Holy Spirit's help, do that the person finds himself in an experience with Jesus and follows him; you must be a real apostle.

In South America I have lived this sharing with the poorest, being their neighbor, having or not having the same as them, lack of water, of light, and learning a lot from the Gospel's simplicity that I discovered in the joy of his heart in the middle on the diary difficulties.

I can also say that I have given the best of me, even more, I was lending and I lend God my hands, mouth, feet, so that He arrives to each person as he consider, because He knows them better than me.

Briefly, I commented that I have worked with rich class youth from different countries, were we done a work of conscience and they have put their careers at the service of his own country, of the poor people, free, and this is possible because of that initial meeting of which I have spoken previously and that has persevered in finding us all at 6 o'clock in the morning in the chapel of the University, before going to class or to work, it depends on each person for pray, to listen what Lord said to each one.

With this we have done some projects: for example, an enterprise where people worked and work nowadays with Christian values, competing in the enterprise world but it has been created by one of these disciples for give work to the poor university students so that they could work in something and have for photocopies or another needs. It hasn't been easy, but the Holly Spirit was stronger than the obstacles. That's an example... it has been more, but so we walk on two levels: the spiritual one and the social one, holding hands.
